Common Sense Solutions . . . to Intersection Safety Problems

Intersection safety IS a county issue!

The majority of serious injuries and deaths in State occur on local roads. All road owners need to take intersection safety seriously. This workshop is intended to provide local government elected officials and employees with a basic understanding of intersection safety problems, issues and liability, and the role they play in making local intersections safer and protecting their agency from litigation.

This workshop provides practical information for common safety problems that do not require an engineer, as well as background information on problems that do require engineering expertise.
